ALBERT MONGITA [IREBU (DRC) 1916-1985]

“ **Mongita Likeke**, besides being a painter, he was also a writer, theater maker, composer, and filmmaker. This multitalented self-taught painter was a postman when he exhibited for the first time in 1947 Kinshasa. Afterward, he was tutored by the painter Laurent Moones at the Stanley Pool school. Moreover, he exhibited his paintings at the Antwerp Colonial Exhibition in 1948. The talent of this self-taught artist was quickly recognised and driven by this first success, he continued his chosen path and specialized in landscape painting. Mongita later became director of the National Theatre and director of Cultural Affairs.






MWENZE KIBWANGA [KILUMBA (DRC) , 1925–1999, LUBUMBASHI (DRC)]


“ Mwenze Kibwanga, born in 1925 in Kilumba, Katanga province. In 1934, he started attending classes at the Protestant mission in Mwanza, where he also took drawing lessons. He left the village in 1942 to settle in Elisabethville and continued his basic education with the Methodists. In 1950, Kibwanga was admitted to the «l'Atelier du Hangar» founded by French painter, Romain-Desfossés. There, he developed his style, bringing his subjects to life through a technique of hatching and parallel lines alternating between light and dark tones that follow the shapes of people, animals, and vegetation.



“ One of the doyens of modern Congolese painting In 1958 he participated in the Brussels Universal Exhibition and in 1966 his works were presented at the first festival of the black arts in Dakar. **Nkusu** is also deeply religious. This aspect of his personality appears in his many religiously inspired paintings. Living very close to the simple and traditional life, In 1978, the AICA/Zaire awarded him the Golden Palette, an insignia that rewards artists who have been active for at least thirty years.




“ **Chenge Baruti** was born in Kalemia on 5 June 1937. He started to paint at the young age of fifteen. In 1955, his bright talent led him to be admitted into the Academy of Fine Arts in Kinshasa. He followed in his older brother Change Kanuto's footsteps, as he also attended the same academy. In 1959 Baruti moved to Lumumbashi after his graduating where he briefly taught painting at the academy of Fine Arts. After that, he set up a studio and art gallery with his brother Kanuto. Together they held workshops on copper ware, sculpture and painting. Chenge Baruti incorporates nature into his work, which illustrate impressive and captivating scenes about warrior gatherings, dancers and hunting. From a stylistic point of view, he likes to play with abundant, luminous points, parallel and counter-lines that give depth.





BELA SARA [TCHAD, 1940-1968, BRAZZAVILLE]

“Bela is one of the best-known members of the Lubumbashi painting studio. The studio was founded by artist-patron Pierre Romain-Desfossés in the late 1940s, as a workshop called «Le Hangar» at the Indigenous Native Art Academy. His originality is achieved by painting with his finger, without using a pencil. This gives freshness and the spontaneity that makes the charm in Bela's art. In addition, such a technique has a decorative effect. The artist's favorite themes are incredible fish and aquatic scenes. Animals from the wilderness are also often depicted: whether peacefully grazing or hunted by man. There are also the initiation scenes sometimes with some fantasy, depicting nocturnal and sometimes humorous scenes, always with animals that conjure up complete freedom. Towards the end of his life, he abandoned the finger technique in favor of the brush.





“Academician of Fine Arts from Kinshasa, where he studied painting for seven years. From 1964 to 1968, he taught drawing in several schools in the capital. Since 1969, he has dedicated himself entirely to his art. **Nkutu a Zowa** has participated in numerous exhibitions in the country and abroad. His painting style is characterized by originality in lines, colors, and forms. Whether it's the form or the ingredients that enhance the values, everything is expressed simplistically on his canvases. Within his style, two distinct tendencies can be observed: one that seeks expression from within and another that focuses on external forms and movements. Landscapes are virtually absent. Most themes relate to the human being and indicate a predominance of femininity.

“ He is an important name in the early Congolese and Zambian painting world, and as such, deserves greater recognition. **Diouf** began his career as an illustrator for UNESCO. He left Congo because of censorship and went to live in the slums of Lusaka, Zambia, in 1974. Earned his living by selling simple art to tourists at the airport and in the city but signed these works “Muntu”. His work signed Diouf, or Moussa Diouf, was his personal, serious art. Undoubtedly one of the greats of Congolese art.


TSHIBOKO MPUTU KABONGO [KASAÏ OCCIDENTAL (DRC) 1948]

“ TSHIBOKO Mputu Kabongo graduated from the Institute of Fine Arts in Kinshasa. In 1975, he became a teacher at the Academy and finally a curator in 1982 for the Academy exhibition. He truly is an inescapable name among Kinshasa's academic artists.

“ Coming from a family of artists, he showed his talent as a designer from an early age. He first studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Kinshasa before becoming himself a teacher in the Academy. **N'damvu** participated in the first World Festival of Black Arts in Dakar in 1966 and in the Universal Exhibition in Montreal in 1967. He then exhibited in Liège (1973), in Lausanne (1974), in Paris (1975), in Los Angeles (1977), and in Brussels and Paris (1978). She reserved a prominent place for women in her plastic expressions so as to depict the woman-wife, woman-mother, woman-Eros, woman-destiny. A pioneer from the outset, N'damvu was a militant in the Grand Atelier where, with Liyolo, Mavinga, Lema, Mokengo and Tamba, she defended the message of “Zairian authenticity” of the Mobutu period.



LEMA KUSA [KINKENGE, BAS-CONGO, 1944]

“ Lema Kusa was a former student of Fine Arts in Kinshasa, where he became a professor and director of the Graphic Arts Department. His paintings are often realistic and sometimes abstract, depicting everyday life with the subconsciousness of a photographer. Women are the prominent figures in his work, portrayed as mothers, wives and children whom men must love at all costs and protect from violence. In addition, he creates paintings that are strong and moral. Kusa's work contains paintings of drunkards, prostitutes, market figures, beggars and idlers with a strong expressionist palette and a distinctive and subtle humor. His various works are remarkably vivid, colorful, symbolic, and sometimes abstract.




“ Born in the Démocratique République of Congo in 1977, **Pitsho Mafolo**’s work depicts questions about the relativity between cultural identity and human behaviour. He questions cultural identity crises and the historical heritage of human societies, with a particular emphasis on African culture. Fragments of bodies half man and half animal often appear in his painting, which tell the realities of an African culture fragmented by foreign hegemony. Open-minded, Mafolo does not hesitate to experiment with new styles and techniques after research or during new artistic encounters which results are reflected, moreover, by the energy that emerges in his works. In practice, his techniques usually involve a collage of golden leaves, printed images, acrylic but also oil paint and unfinished lines on a canvas. These unfinished lines, according to Papytsho, evoke an infinite world but also as a self-reminder that artistically, he has not arrived yet. Papytsho’s work is included in the permanent collections of the UNESCO collection (France), Rotary Club Collection (Kinshasa), Shell Collection on (Kinshasa), King of Jordan private Collection and the D.R. Congolese Presidential Collection.



“ The visual artist **Jean-Claude Lofenia** is from a family with no artistic tradition. He started drawing at the age of eight, initially as a game, but later created sketches and comic strips, which contributed to the development of his imagination.
